Substantivos contáveis os substantivos contáveis podem ser contados através de números. Eles possuem formas no singular e no plural. Exemplos:

SINGULAR	PLURAL
ONE DOG ( UM CACHORRO)	- TWO DOGS (DOIS CACHORROS)
ONE BOOK (UM LIVRO)	FOUR BOOKS (QUATRO LIVROS)

### UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS

Substantivos incontáveis os substantivos incontáveis não pode ser contados através de números. Existem algumas expressões que usamos para expressar quantidade de um substantivo incontável, como: muitos, alguns, um pouco, etc. Exemplos: sugar / açúcar water / água air / ar tea / chá rice / arroz anger / raiva beauty / beleza knowledge / conhecimento fear / medo love / amor money / dinheiro safety / segurança
