Should, Must and Have to

Should – Use for advices and probability - *Example: You should go outside, it's a beautiful day.... – I should be at home by 8:00 pm.*

Must – Use for obligation – (about subjective, personal opinion, deduction; also to express something forbidden) – *I must see a doctor, I have a terrible headache. He must not play with toys in this place.*

Have to Use for obligation – (about objective, external things.) *In England, Peter has to drive the car on the right side.*

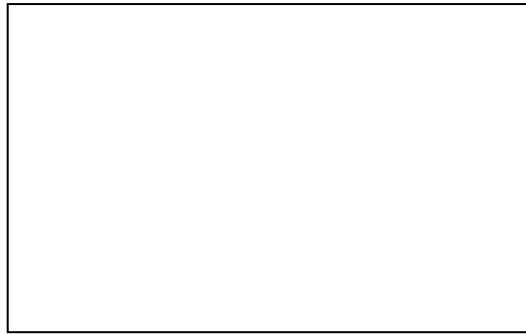
